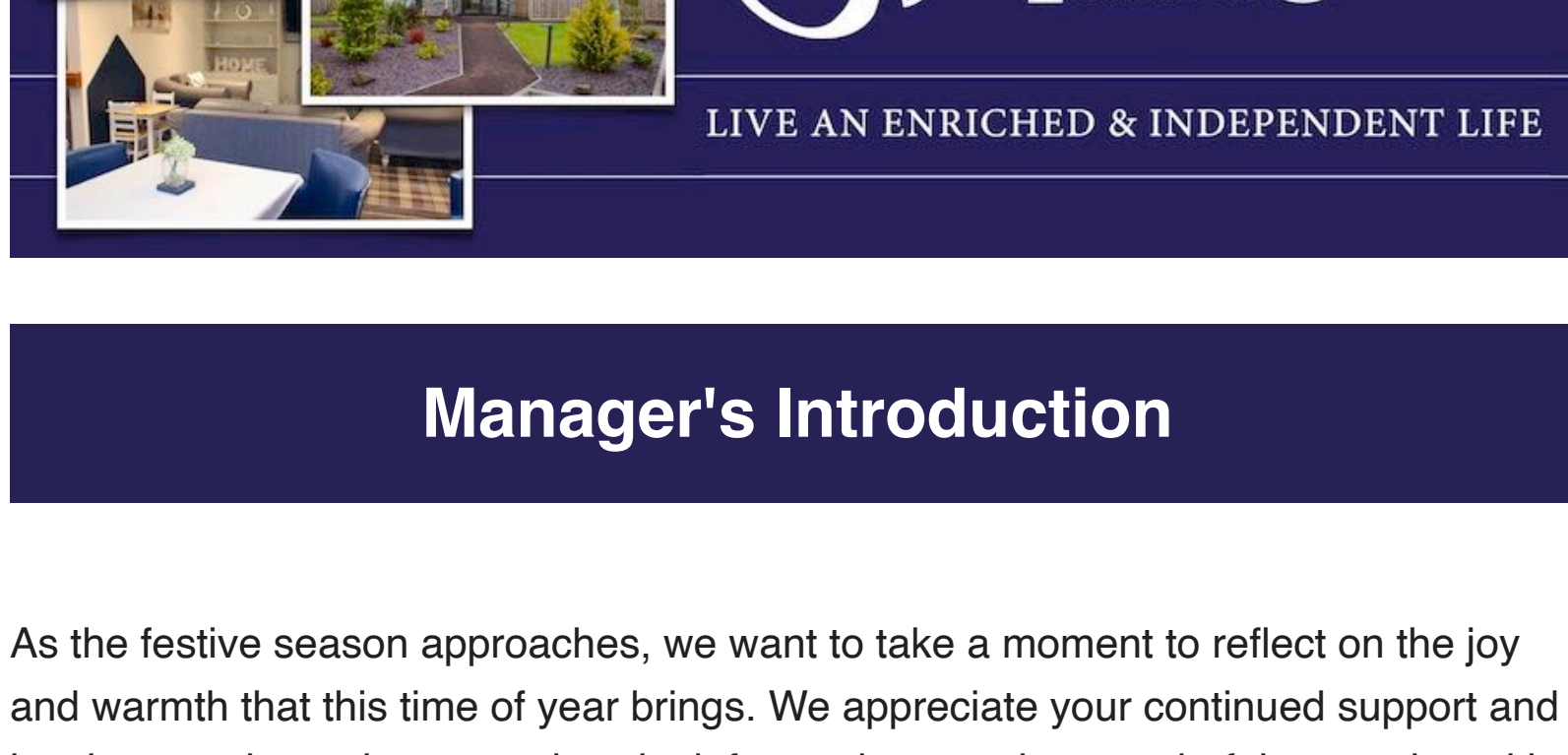

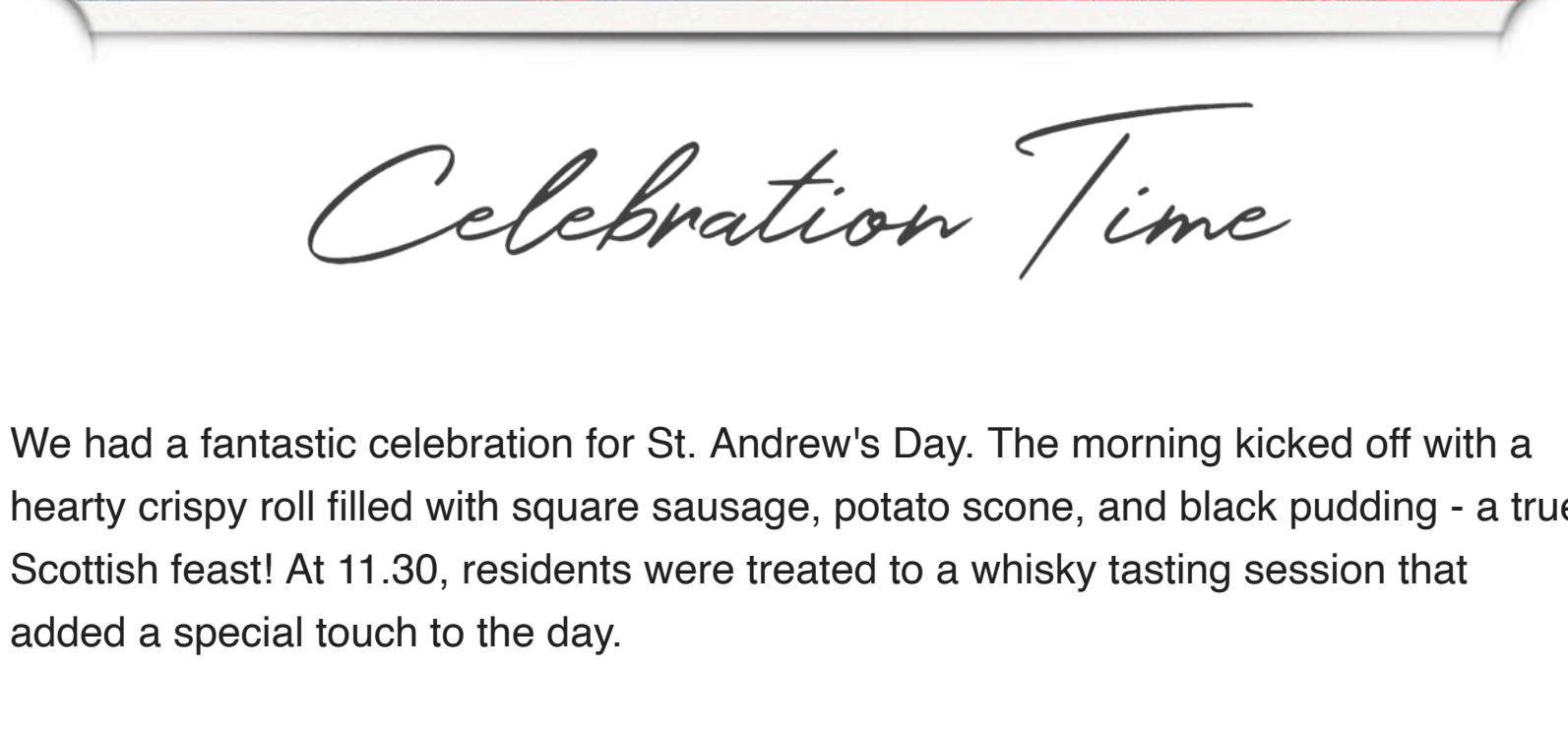


Happy Times!

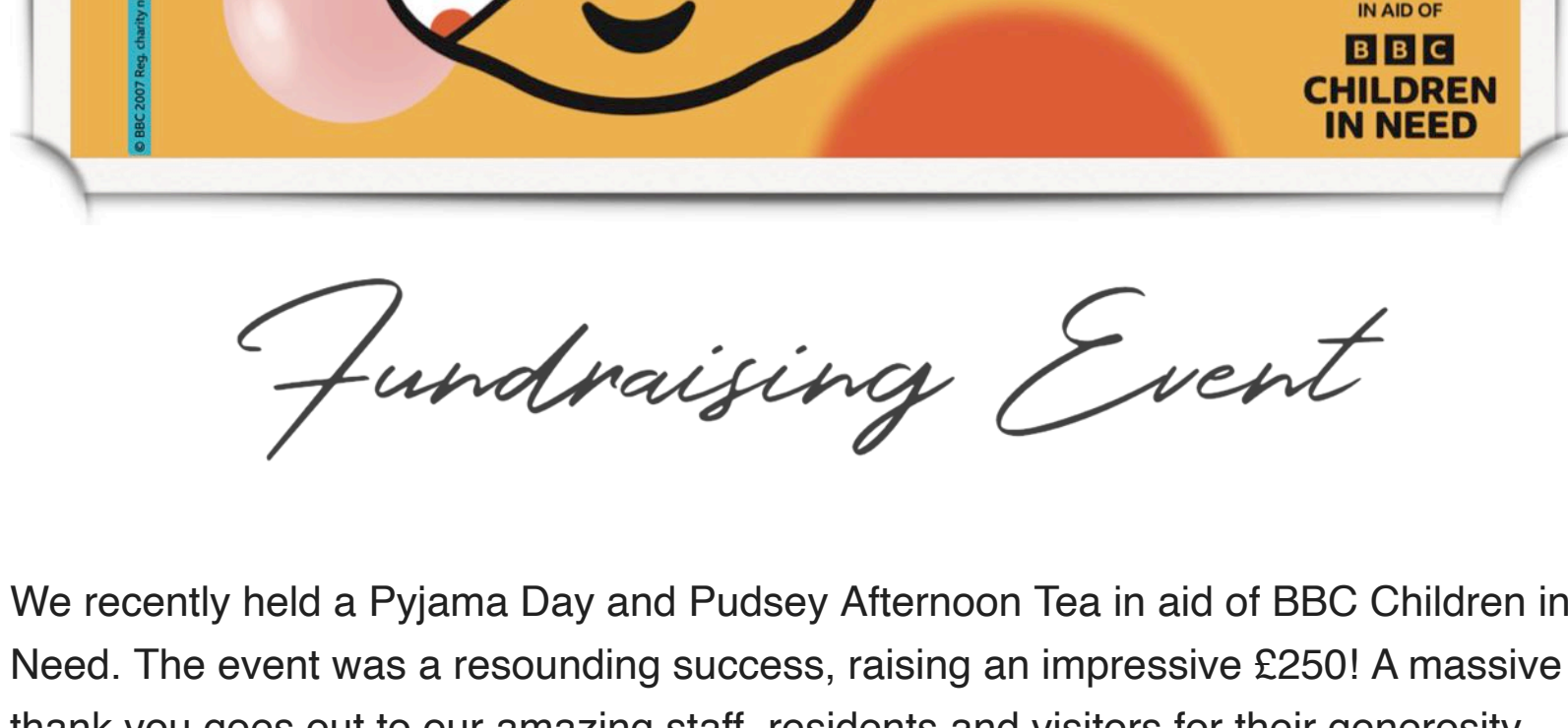

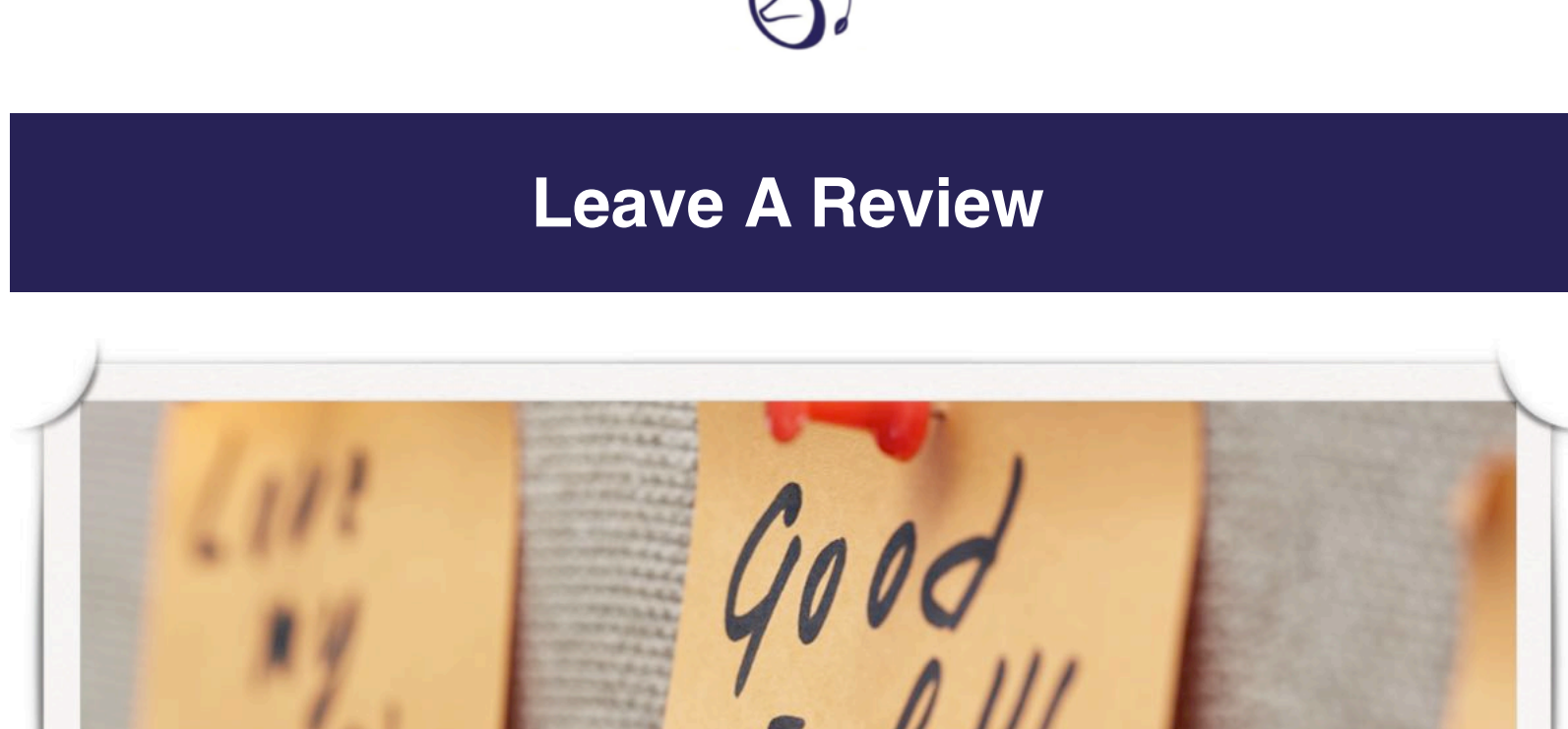


Birthday Wishes
